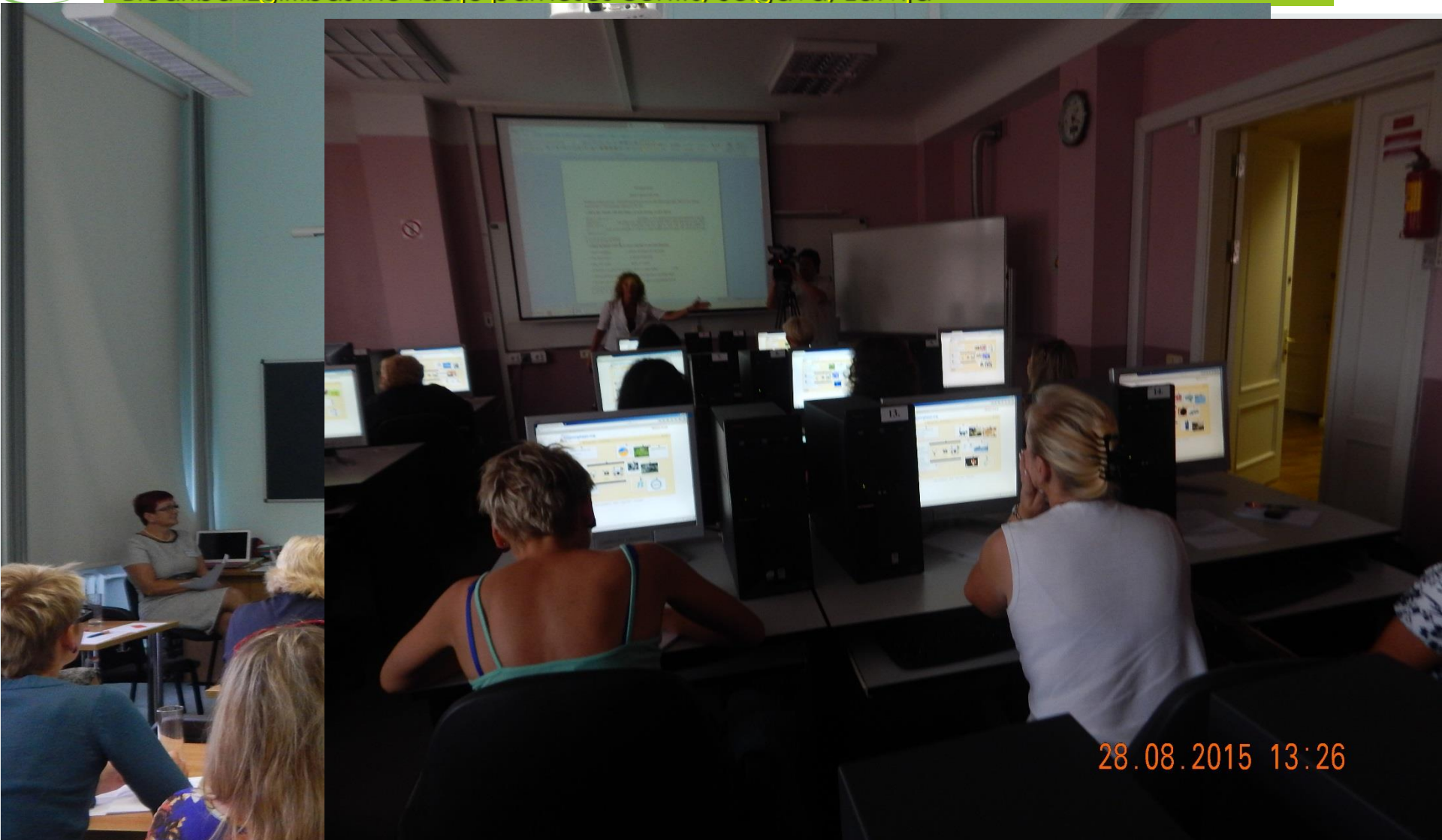
- Language teachers networking seminar, August 28, 2015

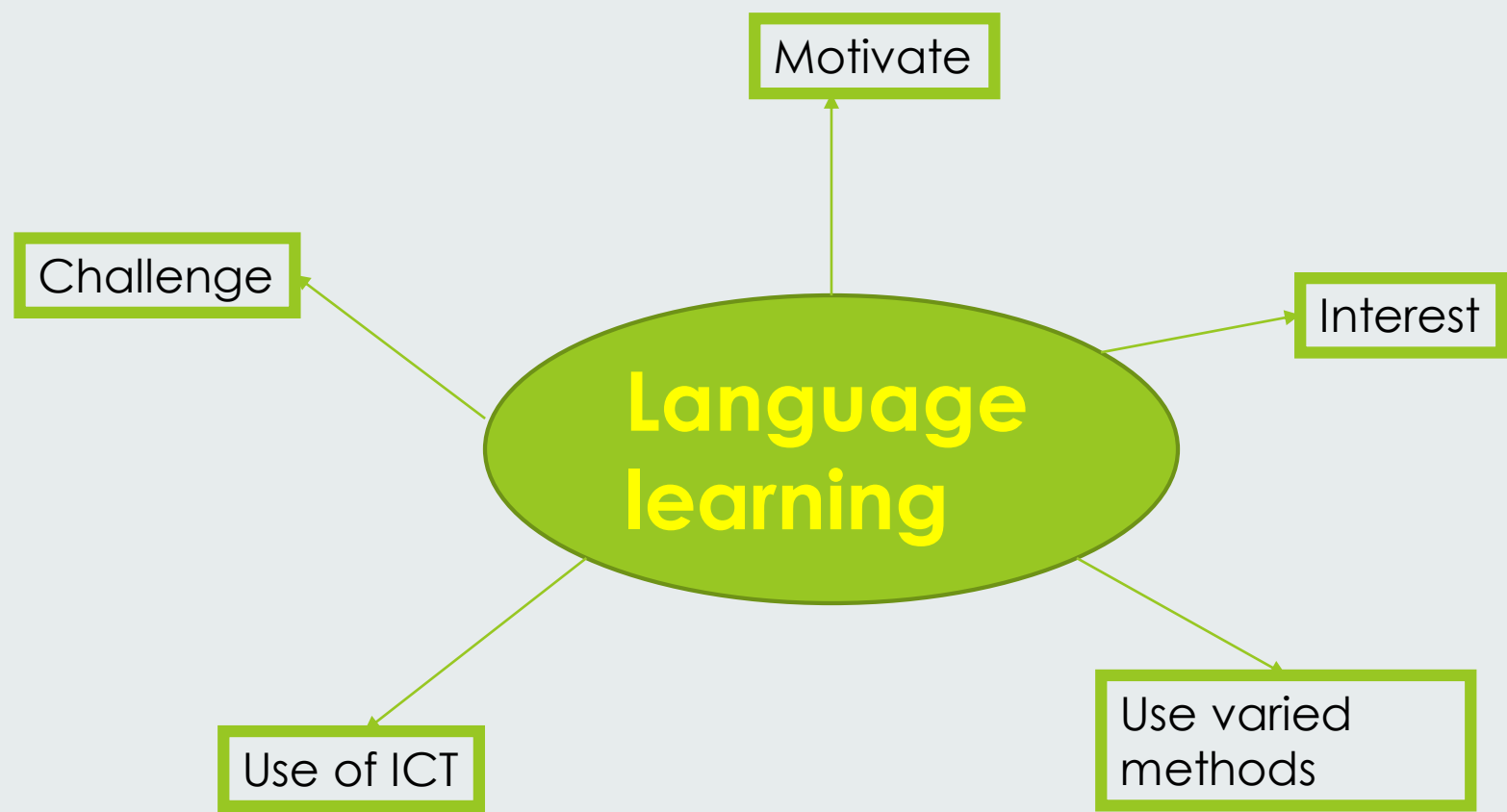


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# Collect views on the modern language learning resources (such as e-courses, video courses, online tests, etc.)

- In everyday use: Web sites (youtube, links, etc.), language homepages; online tests for the purpose of determining the level of the language, individual homework on the Internet.  
**Problems**: there is no internet access in rural areas at home; not a computer (very poor material situation of families).
- + Children use the Internet in order to help each other to perform tasks or provide information.
- Handwriting, punctuation marks!!! (*A huge problem*)
- + save time for the transmission of information;
- Health— electromagnetic pollution, eyesight, etc.
- Examination and opinions of students don't coincide!

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## □ LITHUANIA

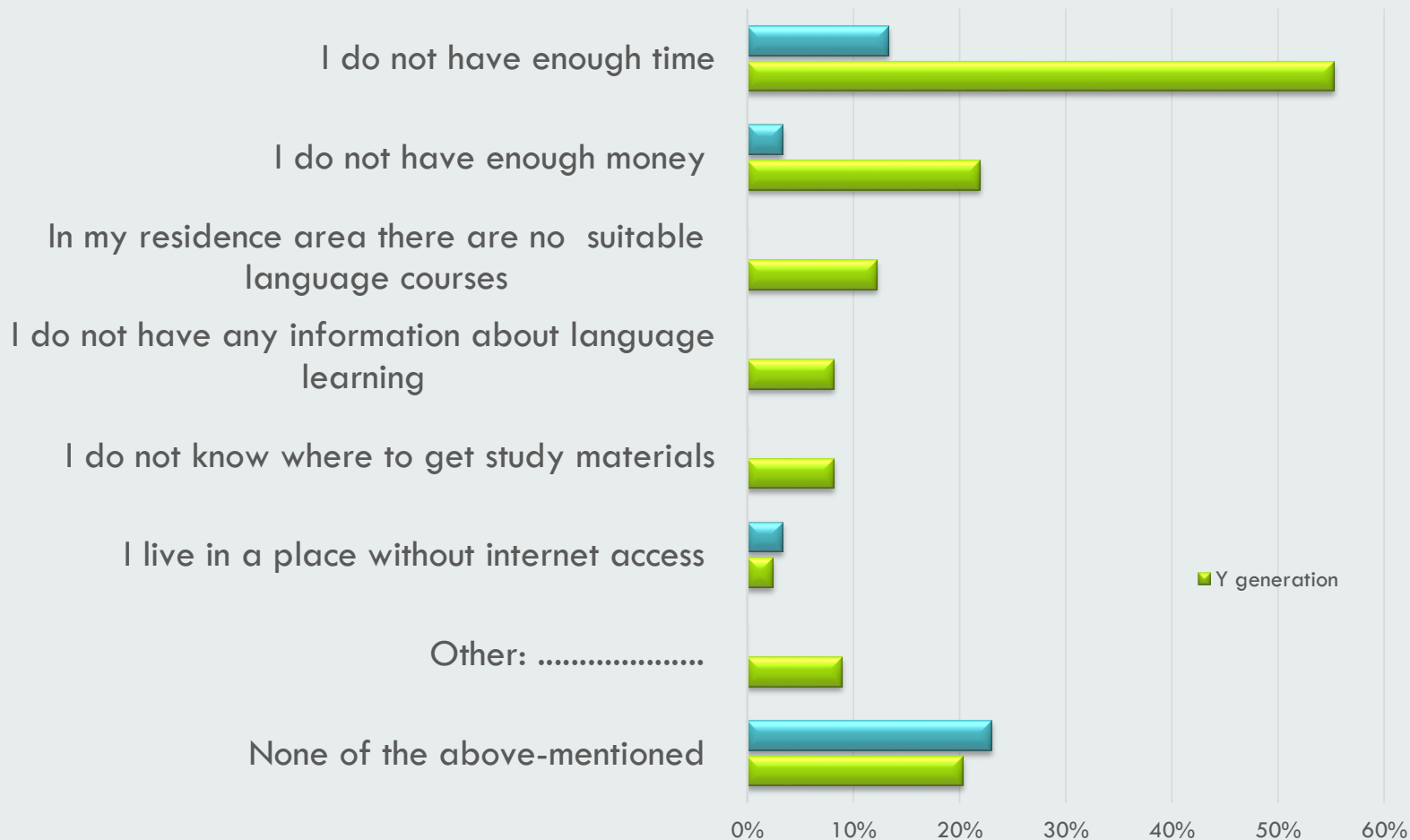
- Internship, work, travel to countries that speak a language that the student is learning;
- Watching movies, listening to music, reading books, newspapers;
- Communication with foreigners;
- Talking, telling stories.

## □ LATVIA

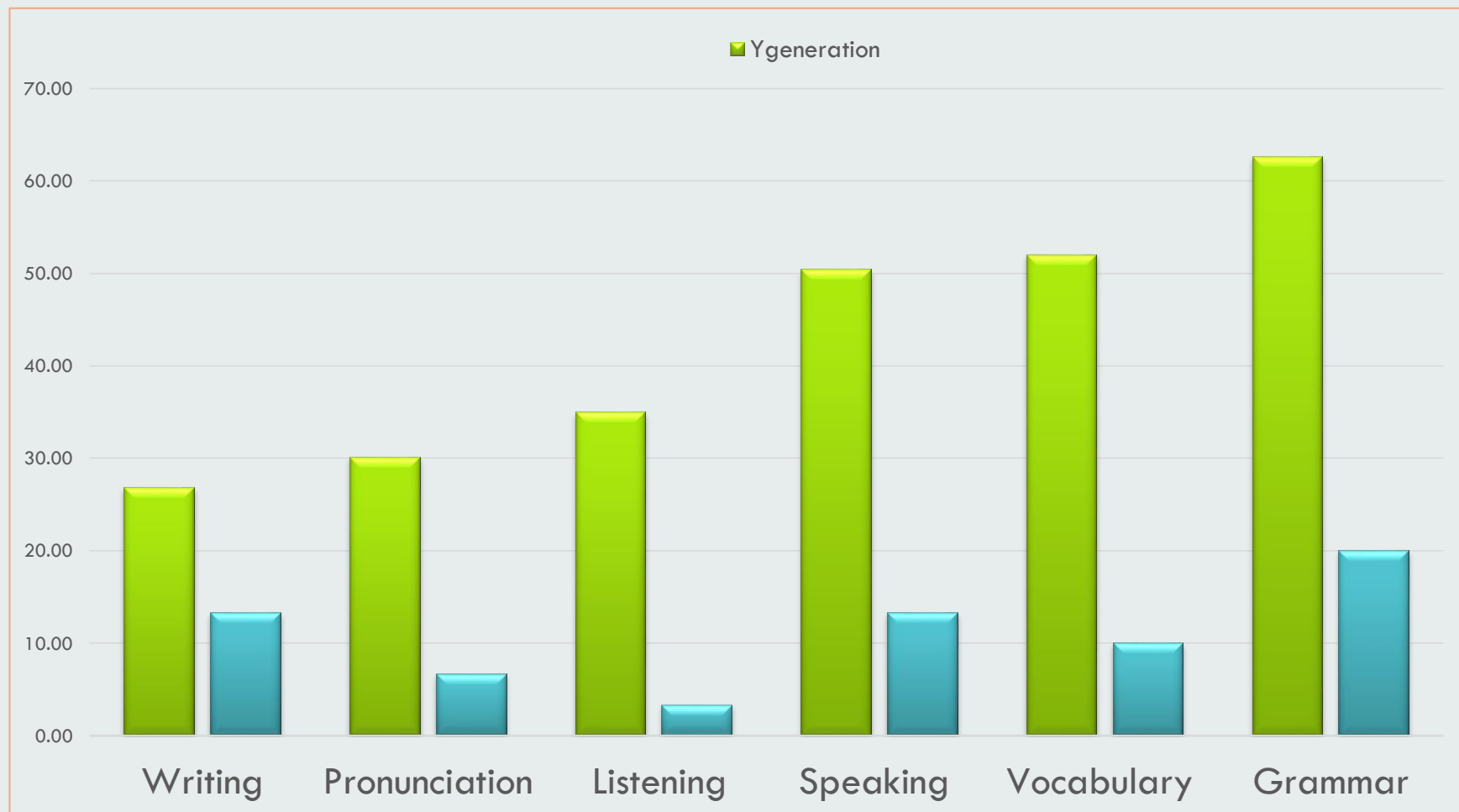
- Try to communicate in a foreign language;
- Overcome confusion if need to use a language;
- Watch movies, read books in a foreign language etc.;
- Use the opportunities offered by the Internet (e.g. learners' social networks, etc.).

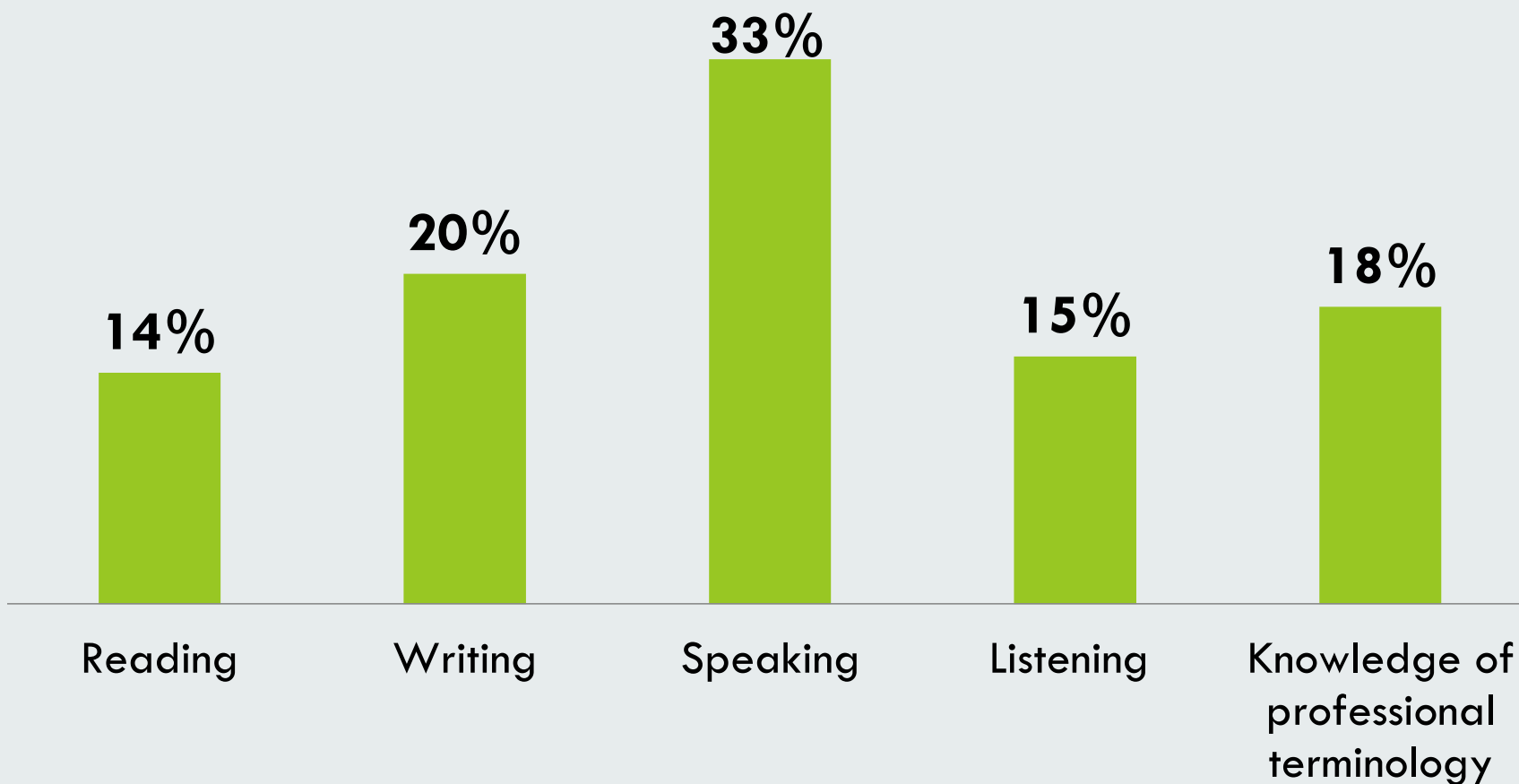

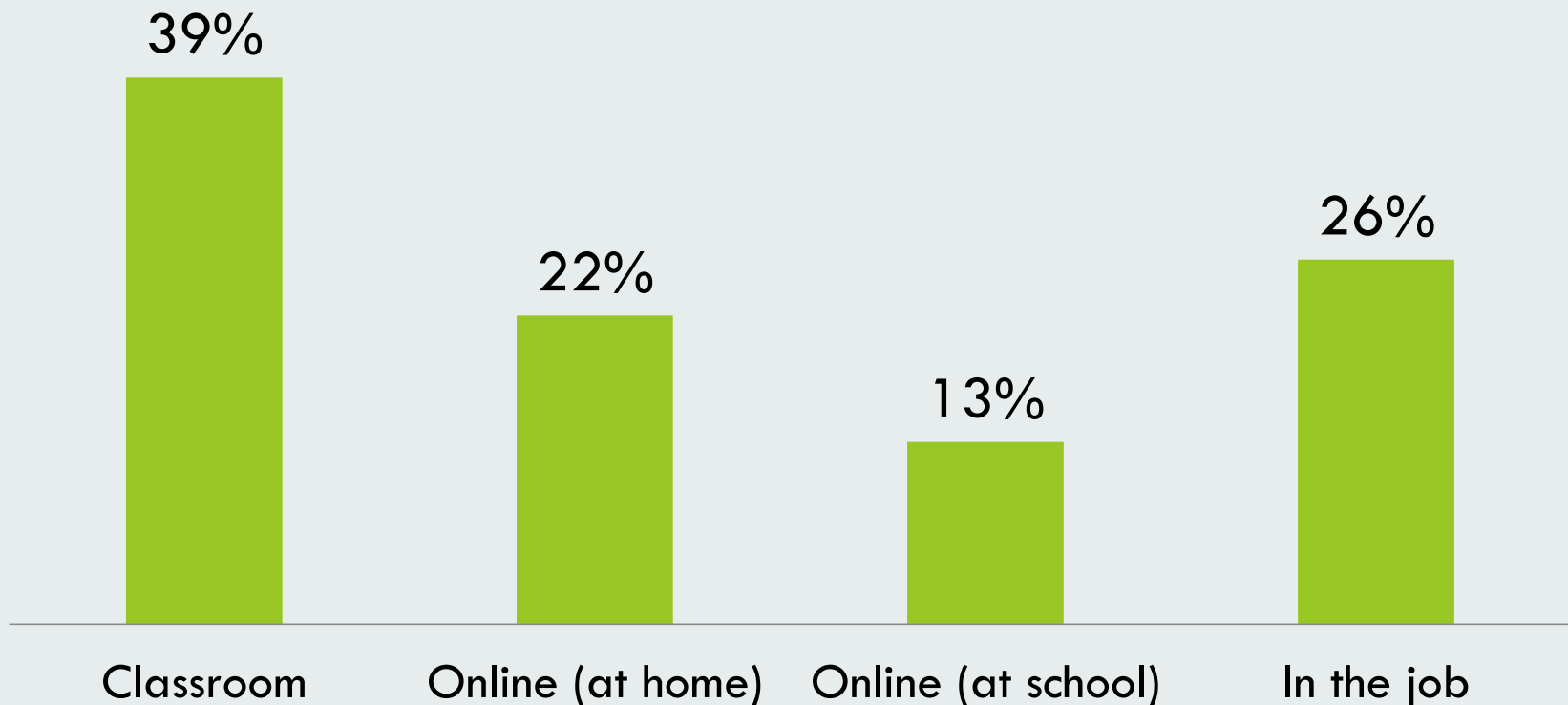

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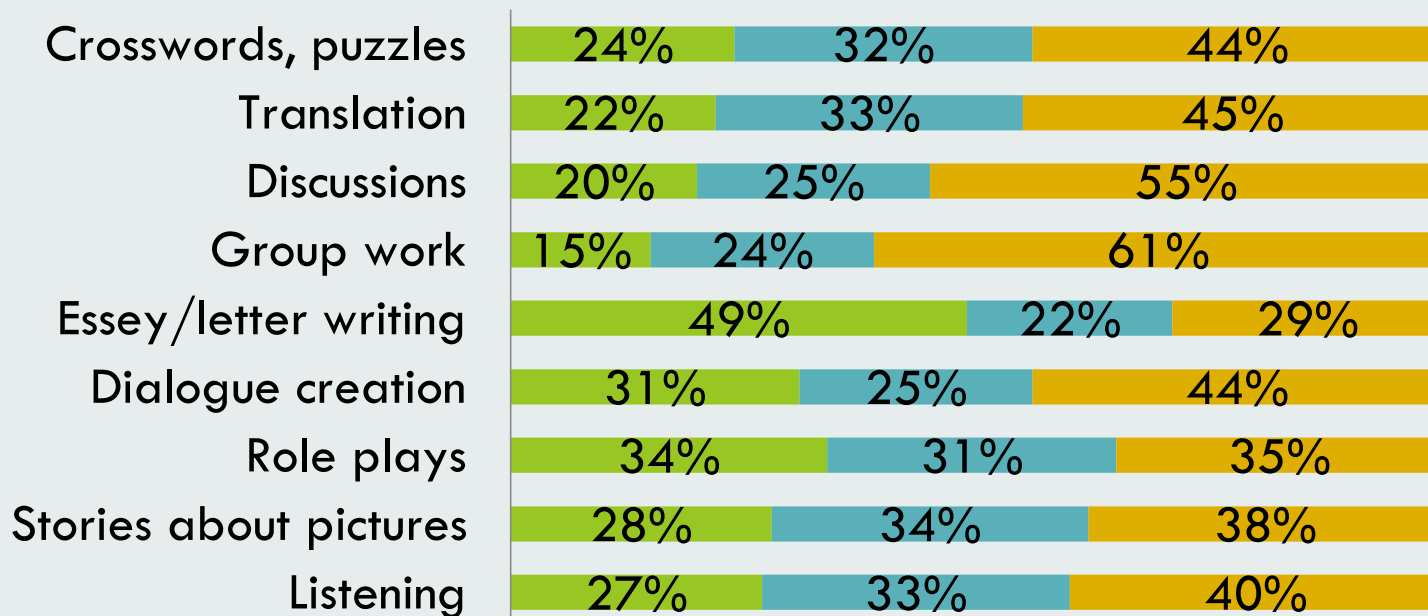
# What kind of learning environment do you prefer?





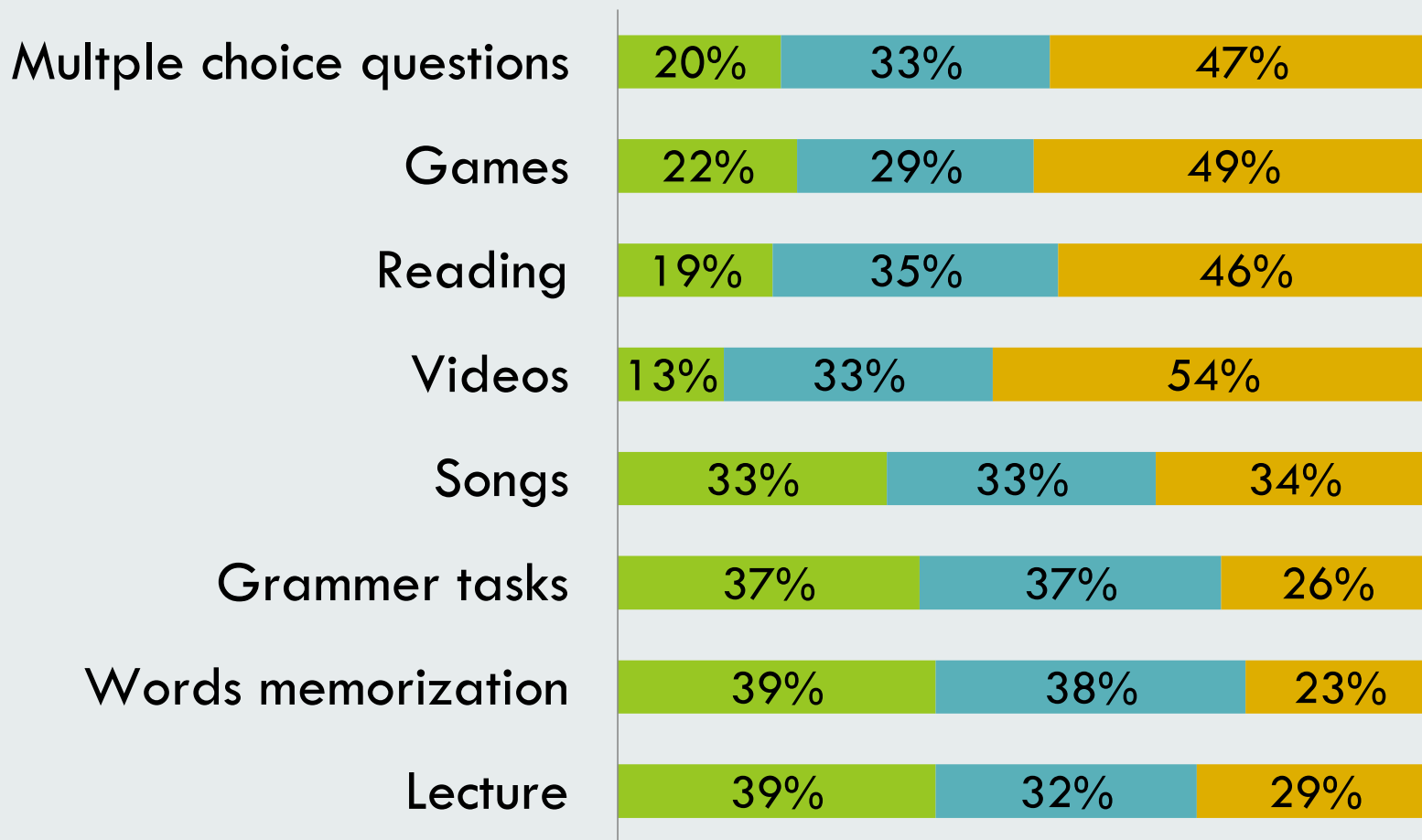
# Which teaching methods do you like? (I)

# Which teaching methods do you like? (II)

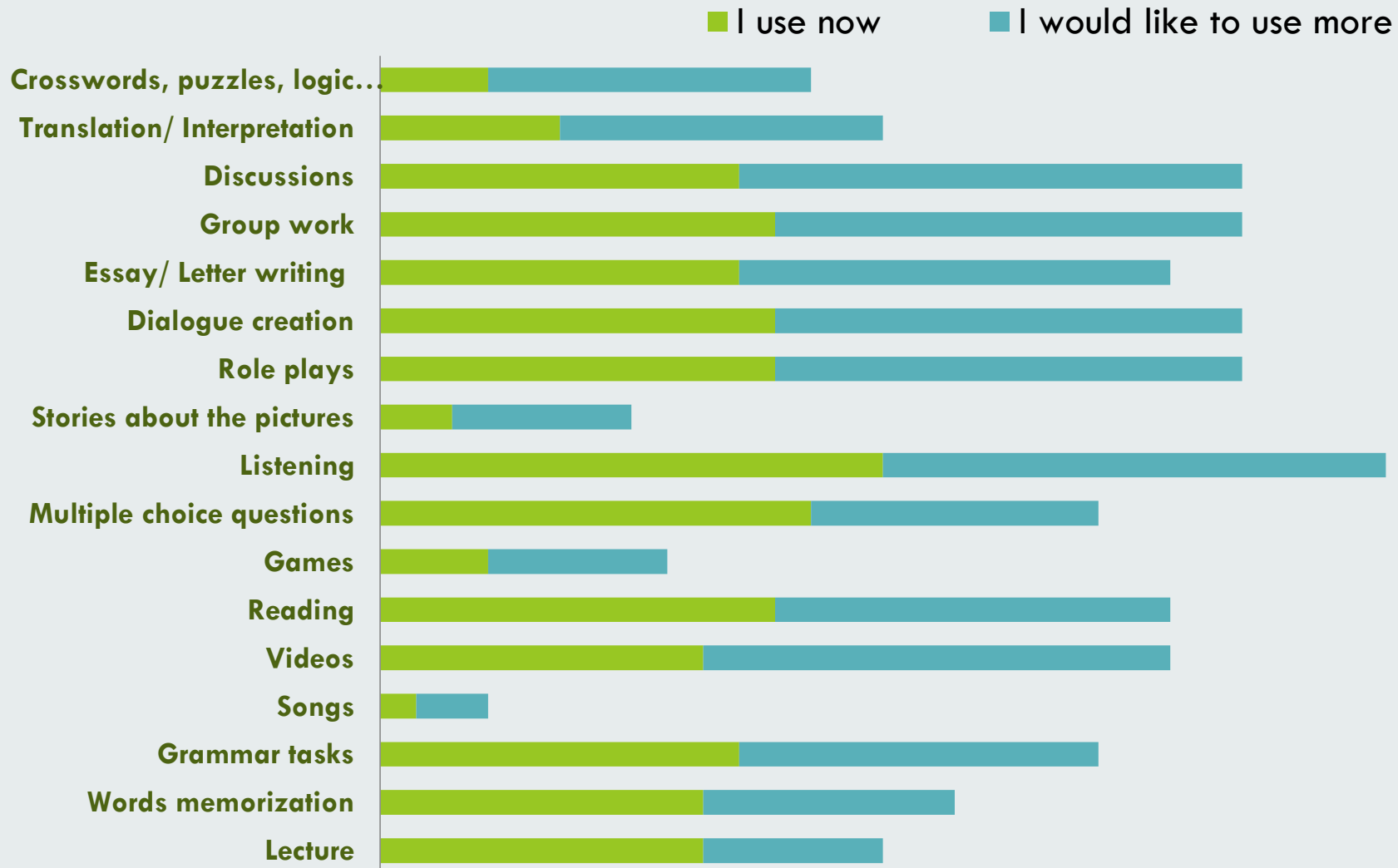
■ Rarely like   ■ Sometimes like   ■ I like



# Methods used by teachers in English classes more often



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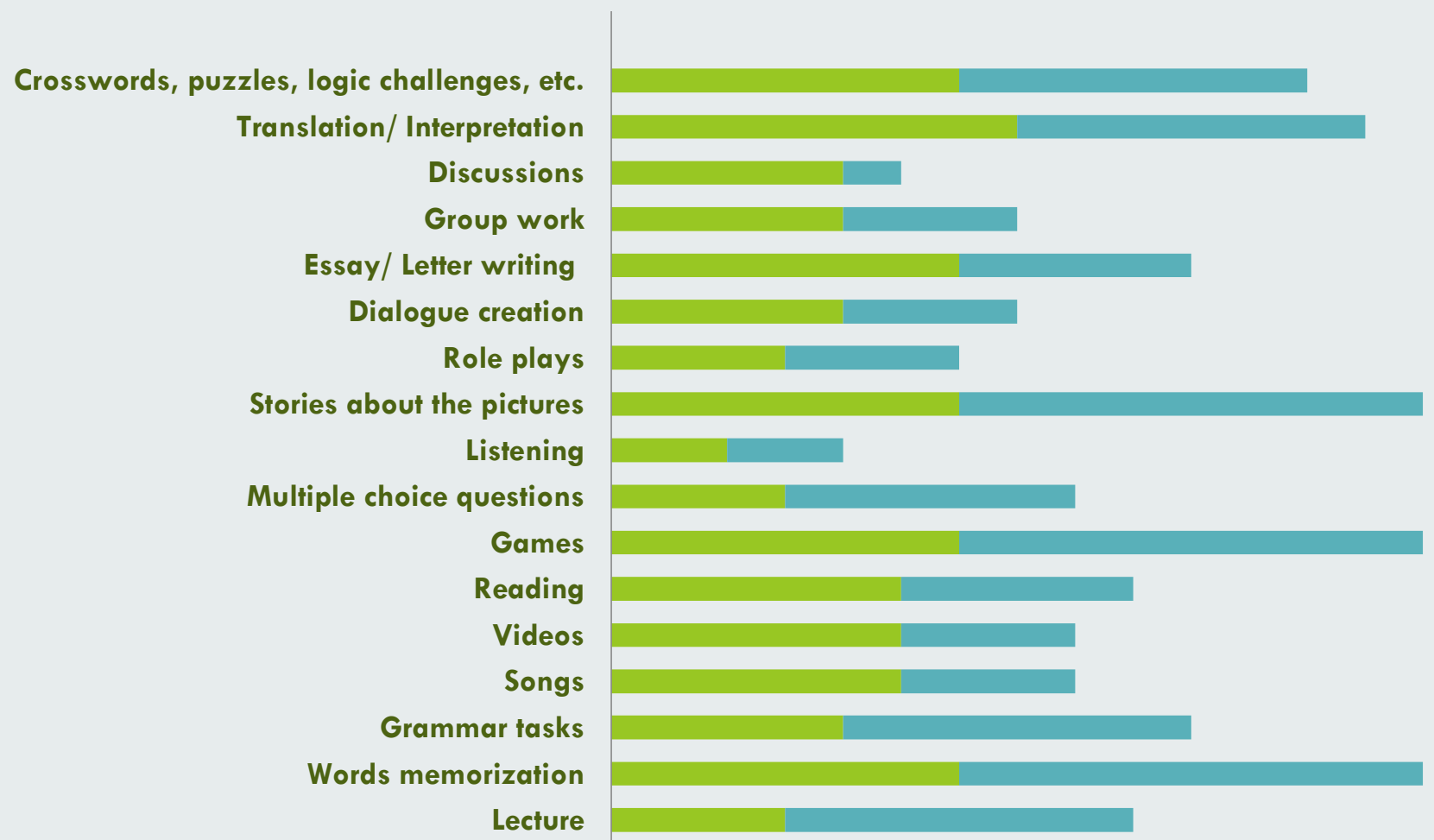
# Methods used by teachers in English classes sometimes



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■ I use now      ■ I would like to use more



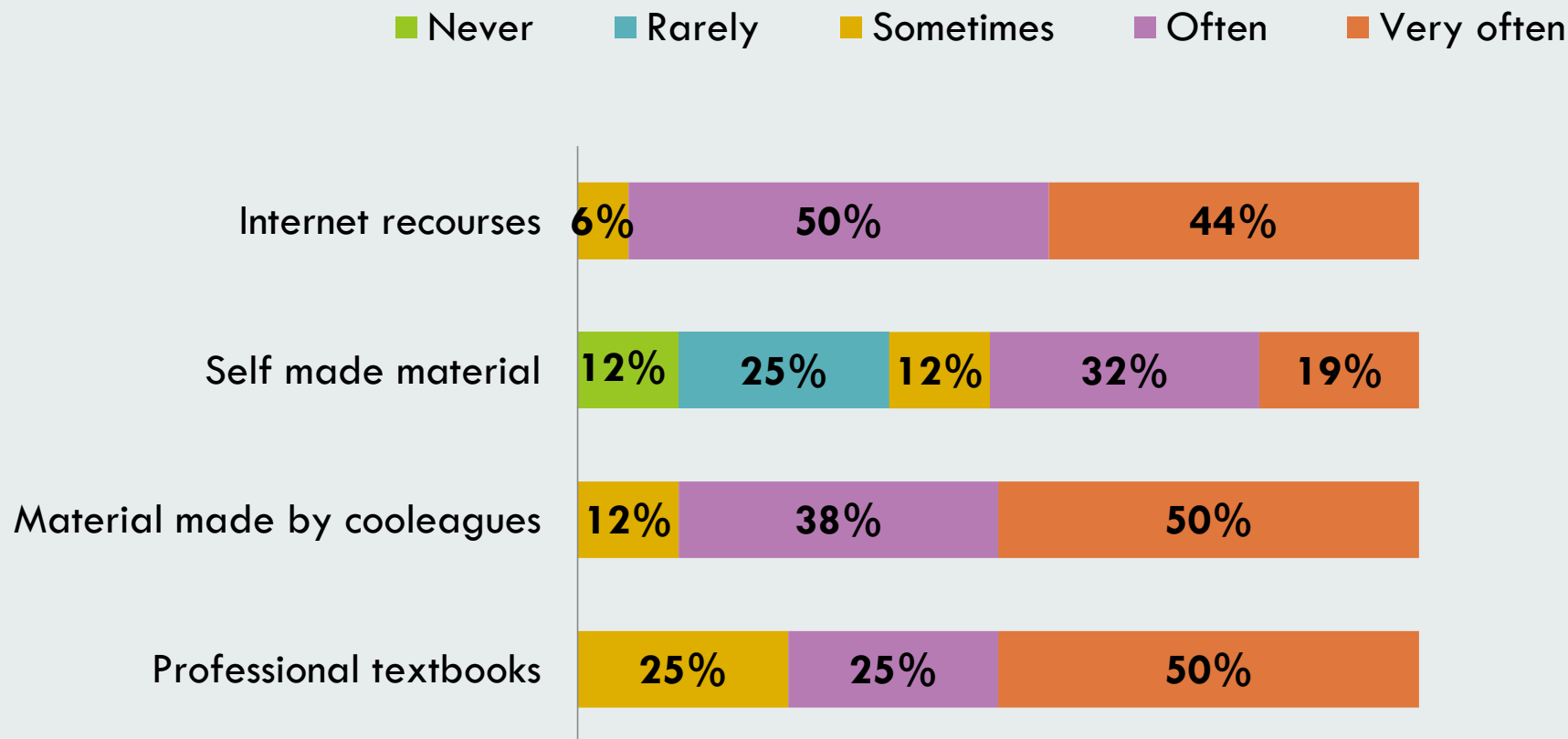
# Methods used by teachers in English classes rare

# Conclusions - methodological dimension

- There are a lot of materials/tools on the Internet
- There are at least four approaches regarding ICT usage in language teaching:
  - Use materials available on Internet (interactive + printed)
  - Use special language learning tools/ webpages/ applications/ ...
  - Use communication tools for working in groups/ getting feedback/ interest students/ ..
  - Use testing tools to evaluate students' language learning ...

# Conclusions – teachers dimension

- It is a time consuming process to choose appropriate materials/tools from Internet
- Materials/tools on Internet should contain short description how to use them and for what purposes
- Best way to activate teachers for usage ICT are:
  - workshops +
  - experience exchange +
  - practical training



# Conclusions – “screen” generation dimension

- Students use technologies for communication and exchange of information but sometimes don't know how to use for learning purposes
- Internet access have to be provided not only in schools
- Students prefer classroom environment as well as group work for learning languages
- There are **two approaches** regarding ICT usage in learning languages:
  - To use ICT for attractive language teaching
  - Use methods to interest students learn languages without ICT
