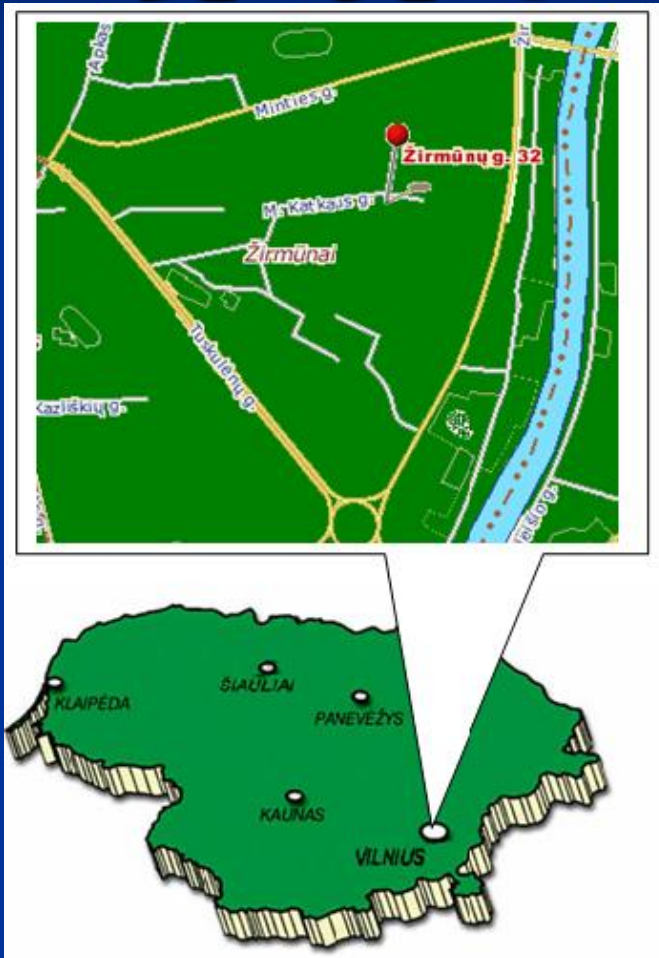

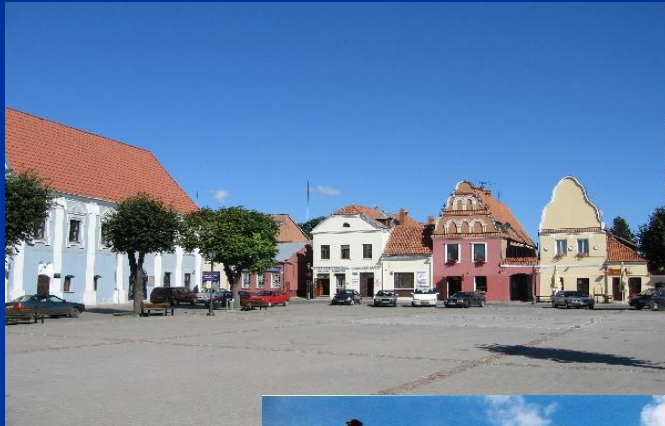
3. Church of Evangelical Reformats. (1631-1653) It is a splendid Renaissance style church, with four baroque towers

7. The gothic St. George's church is one of the first brick buildings in Kedainiai



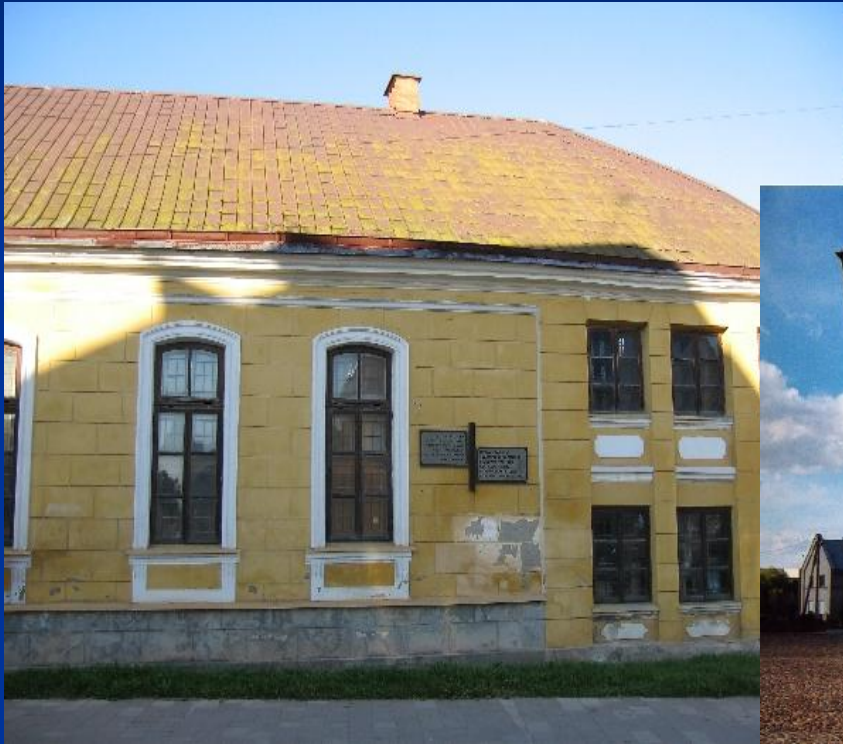

9. The synagogue was built in the middle of the 19th century



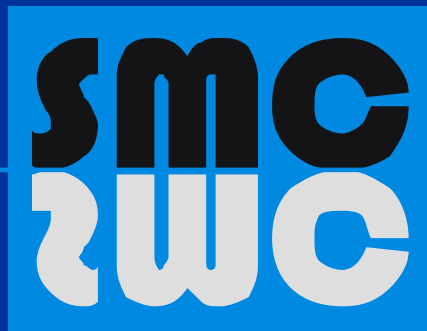
