Multi-dimensional educational process of persons (in age group 25-64 years) which ensures the development of the individual and competitiveness in the labour market



DEMOGRAPHIC ASPECT

- Reduced the number of young workers. It is smaller than the number who have reached the retirement age
- Retired professionals need to be replaced not only by young professionals, but also for people with middle-aged retrain
- Free education capacity is able to actively engage in lifelong learning process
